The preparation is important to this project as well as the materials. Kate prepped the paints and the kids mixed a variety of colors. The paint is applied by pouring cups of paint over the canvas with an acrylic medium to help the paint flow. The technique is designed to cover the canvas in a thick layer of waving colors. It takes about 24 hours for the acrylic paint to completely dry.

WINTER SAFETY TIPS:

The parking lot and street are very busy. Please make sure you and your children take extra caution when entering and exiting the parking lot.
